Discharge Summary documents support the transfer of a patient from a hospital back to the care of their nominated primary healthcare provider.

They capture details about the patient's hospital stay, including the diagnosis, diagnostic procedures performed, the prognosis, medications prescribed and follow-up actions recommended.

The My Health Record system supports the collection of Discharge Summary documents. When a healthcare provider creates a Discharge Summary document, it will be sent directly to the nominated primary healthcare provider, as per current practices. A copy may also be sent to the individual's digital health record.

### Release rationale

Default template packages for Discharge Summary requires an external HPI-I to be recorded when uploading information to My Health Record. Stakeholder feedback has suggested that in the absence of a comprehensive national provider directory, these HPI-Is are unable to be reliably sourced by healthcare organisations that are currently uploading clinical documents to My Health Record and present a barrier for transition to default template packages.

As a result, the Agency has decided that, going forward, the requirement to capture the HPI-I of external providers will be amended until such time as a national provider directory capability is in place (to be delivered by HealthConnect Phase 1a).

New template packages have been created to relax the HPI-I requirement for certain fields, as outlined in the Scope section below.

This release of the Discharge Summary includes the following changes to the *Discharge Summary My Health Record Conformance Profile*:

- Revision of HPI-I relaxation with change in document version from 1.6 to 1.7
- Update to the 2.3.3 Relaxation inclusions for HPI-I

### Scope

Discharge Summary - Template Package Library v1.7 relaxes the requirement for an HPI-I for external healthcare professionals, such as the healthcare recipient's Nominated Primary Healthcare Provider, while continuing to mandate an HPI-I for internal healthcare providers (i.e., those employed by the organisation), such as the author of the Discharge Summary clinical document. Refer to the *Changes* section for the list of data elements where HPI-I requirements have been relaxed.
