Release rationale

This incremental release of the Consumer Entered Notes end product introduces the *Template Package Library* as a new product component. This version of the template package library included contains all template packages available for the Consumer Entered Notes document type at the time of publication.

Of those template packages, the following is aligned with *PCEHR Conformance Profile for Consumer Entered Information v1.3*¹:

Introduction

This release note introduces specifications associated with Consumer Entered Notes Version 1.0.

This solution bundle as detailed below is released with the following supporting document;

- Consumer Entered Notes Information Requirements v0.07

Role

The role of this release is to define the goal-state solution for the content of Consumer-entered notes communicated to the PCEHR through the Consumer Portal.

Scope

The PCEHR Concept of Operations [PCO-2011] states that the PCEHR System will provide an avenue for individuals to record notes within the PCEHR via the consumer portal. These notes are provided as a memory aid for individuals and their representatives and are not visible to healthcare providers.

The Consumer-entered notes are a step towards a strengthening involvement of individuals in their healthcare.

The PCEHR System also allows for independently operated conformant portals to connect to the PCEHR System;

Solution Bundle

The complete solution bundle for Consumer Entered Notes contains the following components.

1. Logical Service and (Structured Content Specification)
 - Structured Content Specification
 - PCEHR B2B Gateway Web Service Specification for Clinical Documents.
2. Technical Services Specification (SMD, CDA Implementation Guide & CDA Rendering Specification)
 - CDA Implementation Guide plus Addendum (Refer Zip File "Consumer Entered Notes CDA Implementation Guide plus Addendum")
 - CDA Rendering Specification
 - CDA Package – common profile specifications for attachments and their formats
 - Clinical Package – common logical model for bundling of clinical documents with referenced attachments
3. eHealth Conformance Profile
 - PCEHR Conformance Profile for Clinical Documents – Common
 - PCEHR Conformance Profile Clinical Documents CEI

B2B specifications associated with the PCEHR are detailed in a separate suite of documents and will be published independently of this solution bundle.

Variations resulting from the further delivery of PCEHR specifications will be managed through the PCEHR change control process.
