Introduction

This release note introduces specifications associated with Consumer Entered Notes Version 1.0.

Role

The role of this release is to define the goal-state solution for the content of Consumer-entered notes communicated to the PCEHR through the Consumer Portal.

Scope

The PCEHR Concept of Operations [PCO-2011] states that the PCEHR System will provide an avenue for individuals to record notes within the PCEHR via the consumer portal. These notes are provided as a memory aid for individuals and their representatives and are not visible to healthcare providers.

The Consumer-entered notes are a step towards a strengthening involvement of individuals in their healthcare.

The PCEHR System also allows for independently operated conformant portals to connect to the PCEHR System;

B2B specifications associated with the PCEHR are detailed in a separate suite of documents and will be published independently of this solution bundle.

Variations resulting from the further delivery of PCEHR specifications will be managed through the PCEHR change control process.
