Introduction

This release note introduces specifications associated with Consumer Entered Health Summary Version 1.0.

This solution bundle as detailed below is released with the following supporting document;

• Consumer Entered Health Summary Information Requirements v1.0

Role

The role of this release is to define the goal-state solution for the content of consumer entered health summaries communicated to the PCEHR System.

Scope

The PCEHR Concept of Operations [PCO-2011] states that PCEHR System will provide an avenue for individuals to enter some health information into the PCEHR via the consumer portal. This information includes the individual's contact details, and a consumer entered health summary which contains:

- Allergies and adverse reactions (including the substance /medicine /device name and the reaction they have had to it), and
- Medicines (including the branded name of the product).

The Consumer-entered health summary may be used in consultation with the individual's health provider, to help gather health information from the individual.

The Consumer entered health summary is intended to work in the same manner as the PCEHR Shared Health Summary. That is, the consumer-entered health summary is one document that the individual amends and uploads to the PCEHR.

 - Clinical Package common logical model for bundling of clinical documents with referenced attachments

- PCEHR Conformance Profile for Clinical Documents Common
- PCEHR Conformance Profile Clinical Documents CEI

B2B specifications associated with the PCEHR are detailed in a separate suite of documents and will be published independently of this solution bundle.

Variations resulting from the further delivery of PCEHR specifications will be managed through the PCEHR change control process.
