# Summary

#### EP-1949:2014

The Health Record Overview provides a summary of an individual's PCEHR and is intended to serve as the "home screen" displayed when an individual's record is first opened. The Health Record Overview can now be downloaded to clinical information systems for display in whole or part and is an enhancement to the PCEHR.

#### Release rationale

The PCEHR System Operator has made the Health Record Overview available as a downloadable document to clinical information systems.

#### Scope

The four key components of the Health Record Overview are:

- New Documents: this contains a listing of documents that have been uploaded to the PCEHR for the current patient since the last shared health summary was uploaded to the PCEHR. It will list shared health summaries, event summaries, discharge summaries, ereferral, specialist letters and personal health summaries.
- Recent Documents: this contains a listing of documents that have been uploaded to the PCEHR for the current patient within the last 12 months. It will list shared health summaries, event summaries, discharge summaries, e-referral, specialist letters and personal health summaries.
- Shared Health Summary: this is an existing specification for the PCEHR and contains information such as current and past medical history, medications, allergies and adverse reactions and immunisations.

• Links to Other Documents: provides links to views and other records available in the current patient's PCEHR; for example, advance care planning documents and prescription and dispense records.

NEHTA's Clinical Usability Programme has recommended that the relevant components of the Health Record Overview be incorporated into clinical system software as opposed to rendering the entire document. The release documentation supports this capability.

To support implementation of the Health Record Overview in a clinical information system, the Health Check Schedule View and the Observation View conformance profiles have been included as part of this release.
