Release rationale

Advance Care Document Custodian

This incremental release of the *Advance Care Document Custodian* end product provides an update to the *Template Package Library*.

Template package library

The sole template package in the template package library has been updated to correct a defect in the MANIFEST file that prevented the My Health Record system from correctly retrieving the CDA^{™1} schema files. This defect did not affect the execution of the template package by the Clinical System Validator.

The template package ID has not been updated as part of this change. The version number has been updated to 40490.
