Applicants will be assessed on a case by case basis and may be required to provide a demonstration of the working product.</p>

TAS	<p>Applies to: Software developers</p> <p>How to: Download the Electronically Transmitted Prescription Software System Approval Form from the Tasmanian Department of Health website and email the completed form to the Chief Pharmacist. Applicants will be required to provide a demonstration of the system.
