

Common – Clinical Document OIDs used for identifiers in HL7™ V2 and CDA™ messages and documents

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This document covers a number of OIDs that are used to categorise identifiers that are used in HL7 V2 and CDA messages and documents. The sections below cover Medicare, Local Medical Records, National Identifiers, and identifiers issued by healthcare provider or other organisations.
