These requirements served the token based model for Prescribing and Dispensing Systems and the interaction with an Open PDS. Although included in the Conformance Profile, Active Script List Registry, Direct PDS, Mobile Intermediary service and Mobile Application requirements were not included for this release of test artefacts
