1. Summary of Release

1.1. Background and Context

The My Health Record system, previously named Personally Controlled Electronic Health Record (PCEHR), was launched on 1 July 2012 providing all Australians with the opportunity to register and manage their own 'My Health Record'. The system allows healthcare providers to upload clinical documents and view My Health Records of patients in their care.

The Release 11 of the My Health Record system is focussed on delivering Functional and Technical enhancements including enabling the upload and access of Goals of Care documents and Medicines View Enhancements.

2. Release 11 – Summary of Changes

Release 11 of the My Health Record (MHR) system is focused on delivering Functional updates and enhancements, including:

- Goals of Care
- Meds View Optimisation

2.1. Goals of Care

A Goals of Care document outlines the treatment outcomes a patient wants to achieve for an episode of care written by their healthcare provider in consultation with the patient through a shared decision-making process. Goals of Care (GoC) will be introduced to the My Health Record (MHR) system by Release 11 as a new sub-type of document under Advance Care Information (ACI).

Post Release 11 Go-Live, there will be two document sub-types under Advance Care Information:

- Advance Care Planning document
- Goals of Care document

Release 11 will enable consumers and providers to access Advance Care Information by providing the technology and support material required for MHR vendor partners to enable their systems to upload, remove and retrieve Advance Care Information (including Goals of Care and Advance Care Planning documents). This includes:

- Updates to the B2B document infrastructure to support the upload, removal and retrieval of Advance Care Information (including GoC and ACP documents);
- Updates to the Mobility channel to support the retrieval of the GoC and ACP documents.

2.2. Medicines View Optimisation

Release 11 will introduce a number of updates to the Medicines View focussed on decreasing duplicate data to better improve the user experience. The Medicines View continues to be available in the B2B channel, Mobility Channel, and the portals.

The Medicines View will now be capable of grouping related PBS and AMT codes with one another where previously two distinct groups would be created.

The update to the grouping logic also allows for the Differs Advisory logic to remove unnecessary duplication, ensuring users of the Medicines View receive concise and relevant information.

All changes related to the Medicines View Optimisation have been made to the back-end of the My Health Record system. No modifications have been made to the request and response message or the structure of the view itself. Due to this, no action is required to successfully consume the enhanced view.
