1. Release 12.1 – Production Deployment Schedule

My Health Record Release 12.1 will be deployed into the My Health Record Production environment on **Wednesday 23 June 2021**. All functionality of the environment will remain available.

2. Release 12.1 – Summary of Changes

Release 12.1 of the My Health Record (MHR) system is focussed on delivering functional and security updates and includes new immunisation enhancements.

2.1 Immunisation Enhancements Phase 3

Immunisation Enhancements Phase 3 introduces some key functionality for users in relation to the information available in My Health Record from the Australian Immunisation Register.

Services Australia will now be sending critical immunisation information through to the My Health Record system via a new Immunisation History Statement PDF on-demand service. This PDF can be used by consumers to provide proof of vaccination.

This new functionality will be integrated within the existing Immunisation View and the Record Home view within the NCP. It will also be retrievable via a new myGov quick link. The My Health Record mobile gateway will be enhanced to include a new consumer v2.0.0 API, which will allow for the retrieval of the Immunisation History Statement PDF.

Please note: Existing mobility applications will be whitelisted against the new Immunisation API in the SVT environment by 22 June after the SVT environment is uplifted to the latest R12.1 codebase (planned for after 5:00 PM on 21 June). A reminder that all mobility vendors will need to undergo NOC testing prior to receiving access to this API in Production.

2.2 PBIs

As part of Release 12.1, PBIs will have no impact on vendors.

2.3 Patches

As part of Release 12.1 there will be patches deployed to the Oracle HTTP Server. While the review of the release notes by Oracle does not identify any impacts to vendors, there is still a risk that these patches may impact how vendors may interact with the My Health Record (MHR) system.

There are no known issues identified at this current time that may impact CIS and mobility vendors.
